#### One Loaf

Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread (1 Corinthians 10:17).

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are thrilled to announce that on **February 14th-16th** Trinity Lutheran Church is hosting its 17th annual Higher Things Youth Retreat! This year the retreat is entitled, "One Loaf." What does "One Loaf" mean? We are more connected today than ever before, and yet loneliness, isolation, and division define everything around us. The devil, the world, and our own sinful nature all work to separate us from God and from each other. How does Christ draw us back together when everything is splitting into a million pieces? Through the Scriptures and the story of Christ's Church, we will learn who we are as the people of God, and why we are one loaf, not just a bunch of cracked kernels.

Our main teacher for the weekend is the Rev. Dr. Todd Peperkorn, Assistant Professor of Ministry and Missions at Concordia Theological Seminary in Fort Wayne, Indiana. Prior to that, he served parishes in California and Wisconsin. He is one of the founding pastors of Higher Things. He is also our Kantor's father.

Picture the sanctuary filled with teenagers, eager for the organ to begin the opening lines of the liturgy, singing one of their favorite hymns, and listening intently as they learn how their Christian faith applies to their lives. Visualize them forming relationships in small group settings as they play games, eat great food and enjoy having the YMCA in Sheboygan to themselves!

We would love to have your child attend this year! The retreat is open to all 7th-12th grade youth. The \$50 registration fee include meals, T-Shirt and a ticket to the YMCA on Saturday evening. We will also have a talent show for the youth on Saturday evening! If they want a retreat t-shirt they need to have the form into the church office by JANUARY 31st.
